WSDC Vision and Strategy Planning Session

In January, the WSDC Board met to have a vision and strategy planning session to brainstorm and map out goals for the next 5 years. As part of that meeting, we revised our Mission Statement and created a Vision Statement. We identified major strategies, tactics and a general timeline tied to a 5 year vision.

WSDC Mission and Vision

Mission:

Guided by the belief that every life is enriched by dance, we aspire to foster swing dancing around the world.

Vision:

WSDC is non-profit organization focused on promoting and growing swing dance, by

- Honoring the past, supporting the present, and developing the future
- Providing resources to expand, educate, and connect the swing dance community

New Rules as of 2019

Tier Size and Number of Competition Rounds

If the leaders and followers fall into different tier sizes, the number of rounds must be determined by the **higher tier** *size*. Effective July 1, 2019, the number of rounds

New Rules as of 2019 (Continued)

for tiers will be mandatory.

Tier 1: 5-10 Competitors. Finals only. Prelims allowed if numbers are uneven.

Tier 2: 11-19 Competitors. Run 1 or 2 rounds (prelims and final).

Tier 3: 20-39 Competitors. Run 2 rounds (prelims and final).

Tier 4: 40-79 Competitors. Run 3 rounds (prelims, semis, and final).

Tier 5: 80-129 Competitors. Run 3 or more rounds (prelims, semis, and final).

Tier 6: 130+ Competitors. Run 4 rounds (prelims, quarters, semis, and final).

Registry Event Structure

Events must have 60 unique skill level competitors and Aged-based competitors although tracked, do not add to the 60 unique competitors needed to fulfill the requirement. Clarifications to the rules are shown in Bold letters below and are highlighted in the rules posted on the WSDC website. Here is an excerpt of Section 5(4) of WSDC Registry Event Rules page 5:

Registry Events must offer a minimum of two (2) **skill level** WSDC Jack and Jill contests at Tier 1 size with a minimum of sixty (60) unique **skill level** WSDC Jack and Jill competitors. (See WSDC Points Registry Rules for additional information.)

a. If the event has less than 60 unique skill level competitors, the competition results will be posted and Registry Points awarded, but the event will be placed on probation for one (1) year and must increase its competitor numbers to meet the required minimum.

b. If the event has less than 60 unique **skill level** competitors during the probation year's event, the event will lose its status as a Registry Event. The event's results during probation will be posted and Registry Points awarded. Member may reapply for Registry Event approval.

Adding a Registry Event

Please note that if you wish to hold a Registry event there was a change made to section 1.2 item 2: relating to event date requirements:

If the proposed event is within 400 miles (640 km) of an existing Registry Event, then the start and end dates of the proposed event must be more than 30 days from the start and end dates of the existing Registry Event.

There are several other clarifications or changes to the WSDC Event Registry Rules and the WSDC Points Registry Rules that go into effect in January 2020. Please take the time to review the rules dated February 15, 2019 that are listed on our web site. Changes or clarifications have been highlighted for easy reference. These items will remain highlighted for the remainder of the year. The rules can be accessed from the center wheel on the website or under the Swing Info tab under Library or
