Required unique competitors for 2023

The Board is happy to announce that we will maintain the number of required unique competitors for WSDC Jack and Jills at 60, through the end of 2023. We hope this will provide our Event Directors some certainty as events return, and we thank the IAC for their guidance on extending this requirement.

Judging All Star Jack and Jill

The WSDC Registry Rules state: "Self-judging contests are allowed only in the Champions division. Self-judging should occur only if there is an insufficient number of available judges." The Board has reviewed this rule for All Stars and has voted to keep the rule as-is. If an Event wishes to have an All Star self-judged contest, they may hold it as a fun contest, but it will not qualify as a WSDC Jack and Jill contest and would not be awarded points.

WSDC Code of Conduct

We encourage our member events to provide and post their own Code of Conduct. We believe that the world of dance and swing is a welcoming and socially supportive environment and that instances of inappropriate behavior are rare. We all have a responsibility to build safety into events and to contribute to the well-being of the dance community.
