Demery Leyva retires from the WSDC Board



The WSDC bids farewell to Demery Leyva, who retired from the WSDC Board in December 2022.

At the age of 16, Line Dancing and Country Two Step brought Demery to the dance world. It wasn't until many years later that he was introduced to the West Coast Swing dance scene. Demery is a Chief Judge at swing events throughout the United States and Canada. When not acting as Chief Judge, he takes on the role of Assistant Chief Judge at many other events.

At home in Jacksonville, Florida, Demery works alongside the Jacksonville West Coast Swing Club to keep the swing community growing. Demery teaches weekly group lessons and dances, creating an environment where people want to learn while he promotes the dance he loves.

Demery joined the WSDC Board in December 2016. He has been our point person for new Trial Events since he joined the Board, and helping many of our Event Directors understand the rules and requirements for running a successful event. Demery has been a strong advocate for our competitors and helped to drive changes to our rules (e.g., Advanced/All Star points freeze, Sophisticated and Masters rules, new venue rules). Demery was integral in the development of the International Advisory Committee (IAC). He has been part of the Chief Judges training (still in progress), and has been a great asset to the Board for the past six years. We will miss him!
