## New rule change in reporting of scores

The Board has approved a rule change that event scores must be submitted within **3 days** of the event close, effective immediately.

While it is rare that events fail to submit their scores promptly, we recently had an issue where an on-time (5 days) submission of scores by one event affected the following week's event, because competitors' placements (and points) at the first event changed their competition level. The delay affected the registration team at the second event from being able to confirm the competitors' levels during contest signups.

## Preparing for staff emergencies

We have had a few recent cases where staff have not been able to attend an event due to Covid-19 or other emergencies. Preparing for these contingences has always been a part of good event management. The risk of Covid-19 has decreased considerably, but you should still plan for unforeseen staff shortages. There always seems to be a need for extra judges for situations in which a judge can not attend, the judge has an emergency during the weekend, or when the Judge has a conflict of interests with a particular competitor (i.e. the competitor is their spouse).
